Woodbridge, ON – November 15, 2021 – Several BC highways are closed due to heavy rainfall which has caused mudslides and rockslides. The affected highways are completely blocked, and some are heavily damaged.

CP and CN rail lines have also reported track closures and delays in different areas.

CP is experiencing a track outage on the Cascade subdivision, north of Hope, BC. CN is also experiencing an outage on the Yale subdivision, near Chilliwack, BC. Both outages are impacting mainline train operations in those areas.

CP teams are on site and will shortly begin inspecting our tracks on the Cascade subdivision. Further broadcasts will be sent as the results of the inspection are known. Currently there is no timeframe for service to resume in the affected area.
